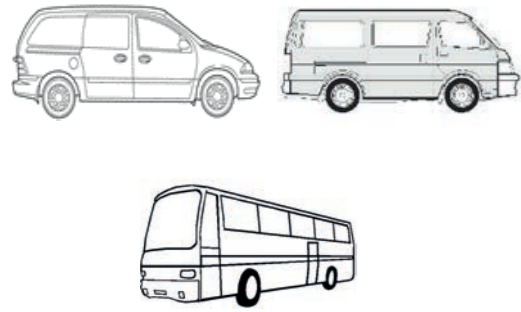


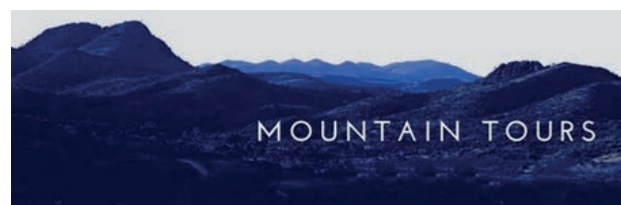

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## Cedars , Qozhaya & Kadisha



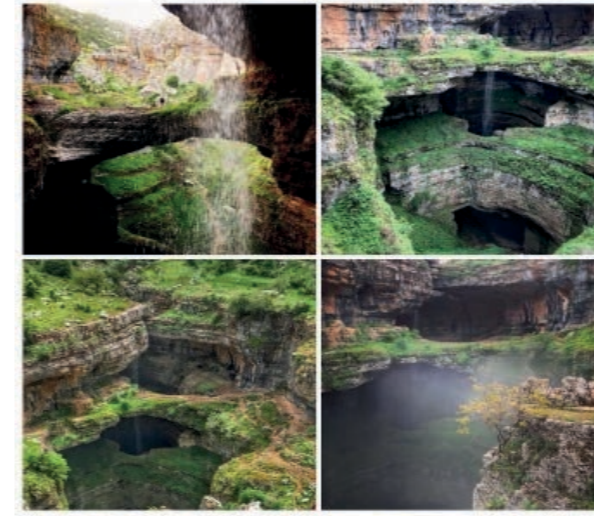
- Check the most venerable representatives of the Cedars of Lebanon, which once covered the country's mountains.
- Discover Becharreh, the birthplace of the famous Lebanese poet Gibran Khalil Gibran
- The QadishaValley, a UNESCO Word Heritage site, is a must see in Lebanon. Located in a deep gorge, it stretches for 50 kilometers all the way from al-Koura to Bcharre. With its spectacular scenery, the valley houses the first Christian monasteries and (cave) churches of Lebanon.

- Byblos is one of the oldest towns in the world that goes back at least 7,000 years.

## Balouaa balaa

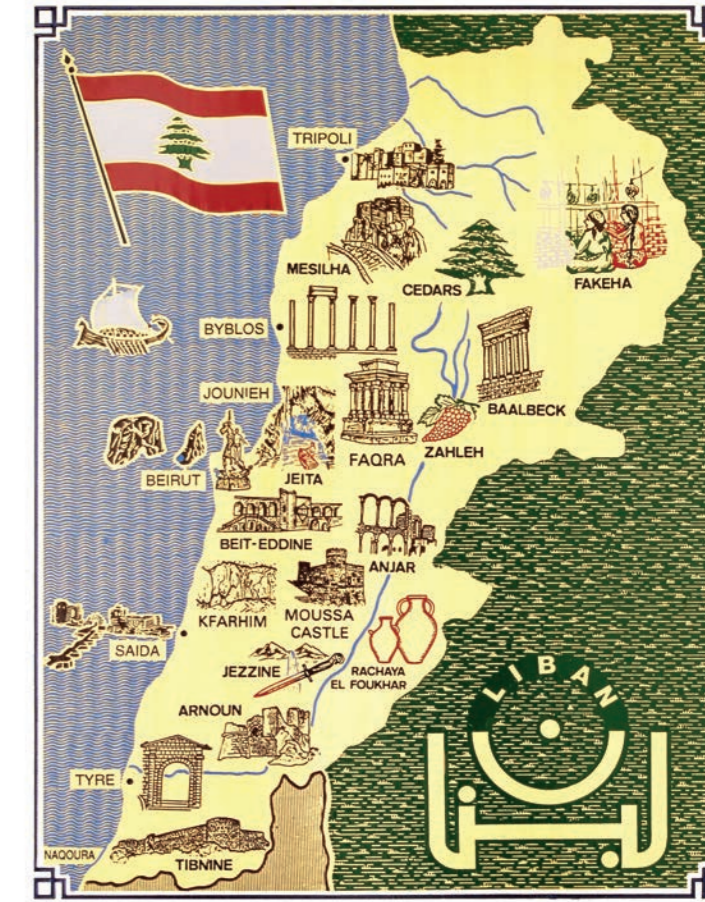


- The Balaa Pit or Baatara gorge waterfall (also known as Balouaa Balaa) is very famous, it is one of the 10 most beautiful waterfalls of the world, and it is a triple natural bridge located by the tiny village of Balaa in the Tannourine area on the slopes of Mount Lebanon.

## Baalbeck, Anjar & Ksara



- Heliopolis, the roman temples of Baalbeck, makes up the largest and best preserved corpus of roman architecture left around

- Visit Ksara , the refuge of the well known Ksara wine

## Sidon, Tyre



- Sidon is of immense antiquity, but few remains of the ancient city have survived the ravages of time and man.
- Tyre is an ancient Phoenician city and the legendary birthplace of Europa and Dido (Elissa). Today it is the fourth largest city in Lebanon and houses one of the nation's major ports.

## Hermel assi river



- Rafting In Assi River for 8 Km length, It's a rafting day with the white water & exploring historical Hermel

## Beiteddine, Deir El Qamar & Moussa Castle



- Explore Beirut, the cultural and commercial center of the country, and check its main landmarks.
- Visit the magnificent Beiteddine palace, built at the beginning of the 19th century by Emir Bechir II, who reigned over Lebanon for more than 50 years.
- Discover Deir el Kamar, a typical Lebanese village with its historical center, souk (market), museum, mosque & churches.
- The Moussa Castle is not a typical castle in any way. It was projected and built by one man, Moussa Abdel Karim Al Maamari. This unique castle contains a wax museum that depicts scenes from the daily life of the people who inhabit Lebanon's mountainous regions.
